ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Present a research project linked to one of the four themes of the Foundation
 - 2) Be nominated by a university.
 - 3) Citizenship requirements:
 - Be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant applying to a doctoral program in the social sciences and humanities or registered full-time in the first or second year of such a program at a Canadian university
- OR
- Be a Canadian citizen applying to a doctoral program in the social sciences and humanities or registered full-time in the first or second year of such a program at a foreign university
- OR
- Be a foreign national [with a preference for candidates from the developing world] applying to a doctoral program in the social sciences and humanities or registered full-time in the first or second year of such a program at a Canadian university

Trudeau Scholarship Application Instructions

To apply for the Trudeau Scholarship, the following application materials must be submitted:

Student Information

Complete the student profile and Trudeau online application. To access the online application at <https://humsci.stanford.edu/current-students/fellowships-and-funding> scroll down to Trudeau, click on button "Apply Now".

All Trudeau application materials must be submitted **online** by the deadline. Incomplete applications **WILL NOT** be considered. The H&S Dean's Office will screen through its own review procedures, forwarding the finalist to the Office of the Vice Provost for Graduate Education (VPGE) for university nomination selection.

A complete online application will include the following:

1. H&S Online Application Form (completed online)
2. TRUDEAU FOUNDATION APPLICATION UPLOAD: Duly completed digital Trudeau application form (upload as PDF). Application form can be found at: <https://trudeaufdn.fluxx.io/apply/scholars> (click "yes" on dropdown box).
3. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT UPLOAD: Single file including scans of **all** post-secondary transcripts (except CEGEP). At a minimum, this should include your current **official** Stanford transcript. (upload as DOC, JPG, or PDF).
4. CEGEP TRANSCRIPT UPLOAD: If applicable (upload as PDF, DOC or DOCX)
5. Three letters of reference: two from academic referees, principally concerning academic achievements, AND one from a non-academic referee, concerning the non-academic aspects of the application. The letters of reference must be signed and must clearly indicate the name and contact information of the referee. (You will enter recommender information once you initiate your online application).

It is highly recommended that you notify your recommender(s) well in advance of the application deadline to provide them with adequate time to write their letter. In the online application system, you can request a letter from your recommender(s) before you submit your own application materials.
